Membership

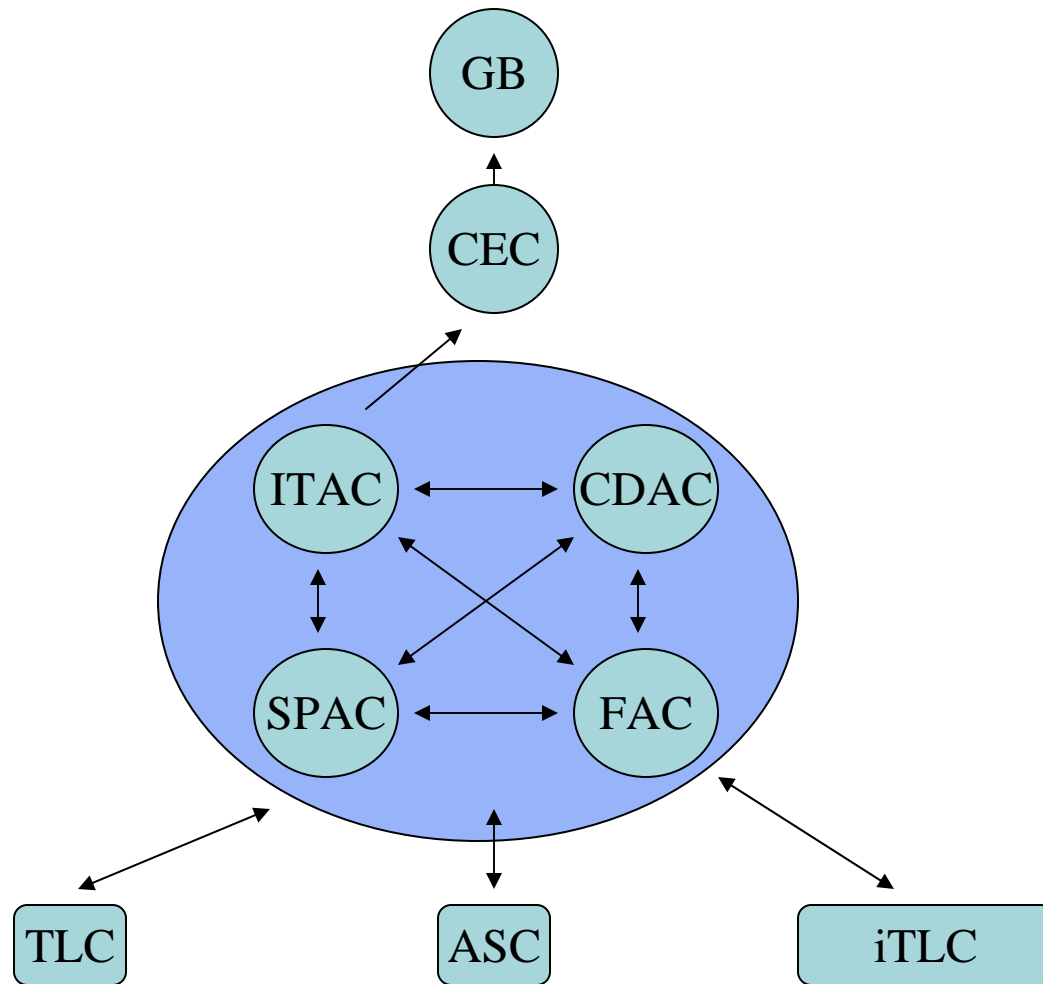

3 distinct processes focused on technology

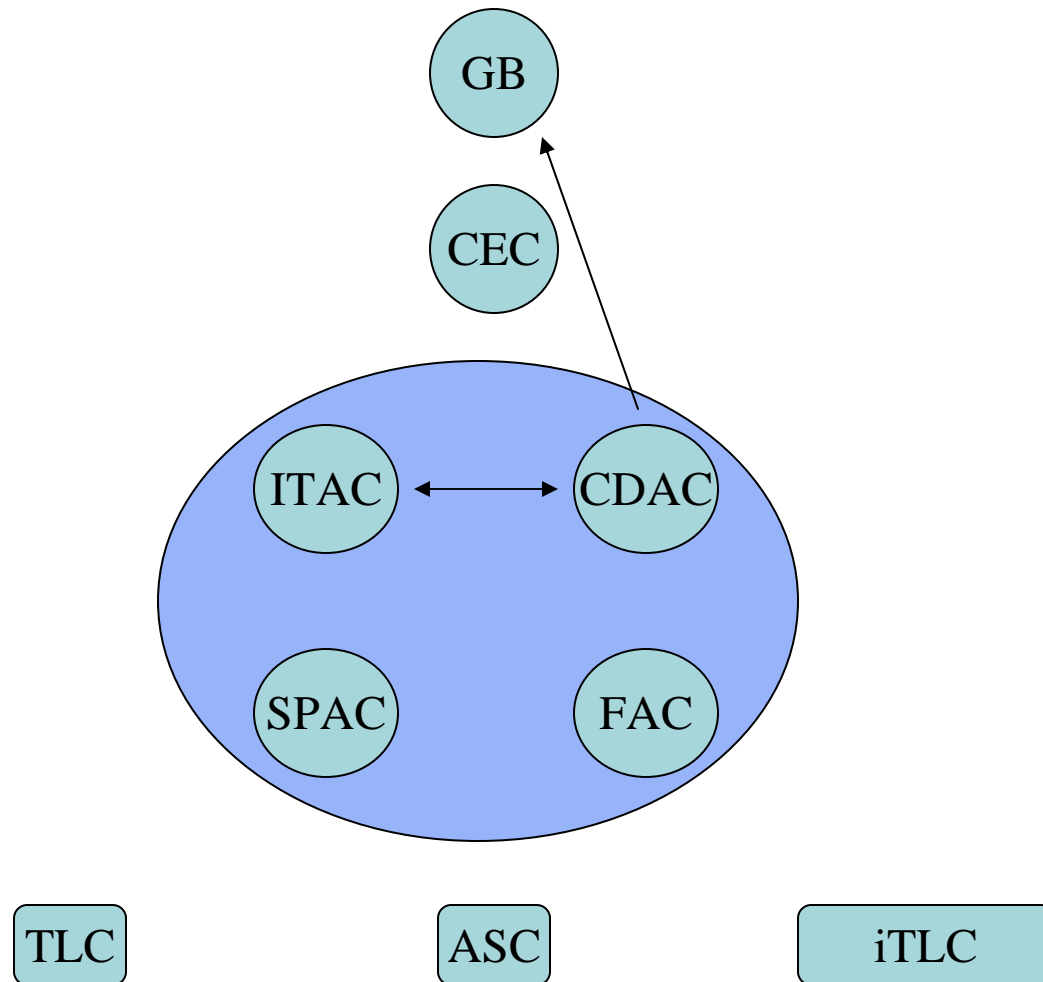
- Visioning and direction

Visioning, direction, standards, guidelines



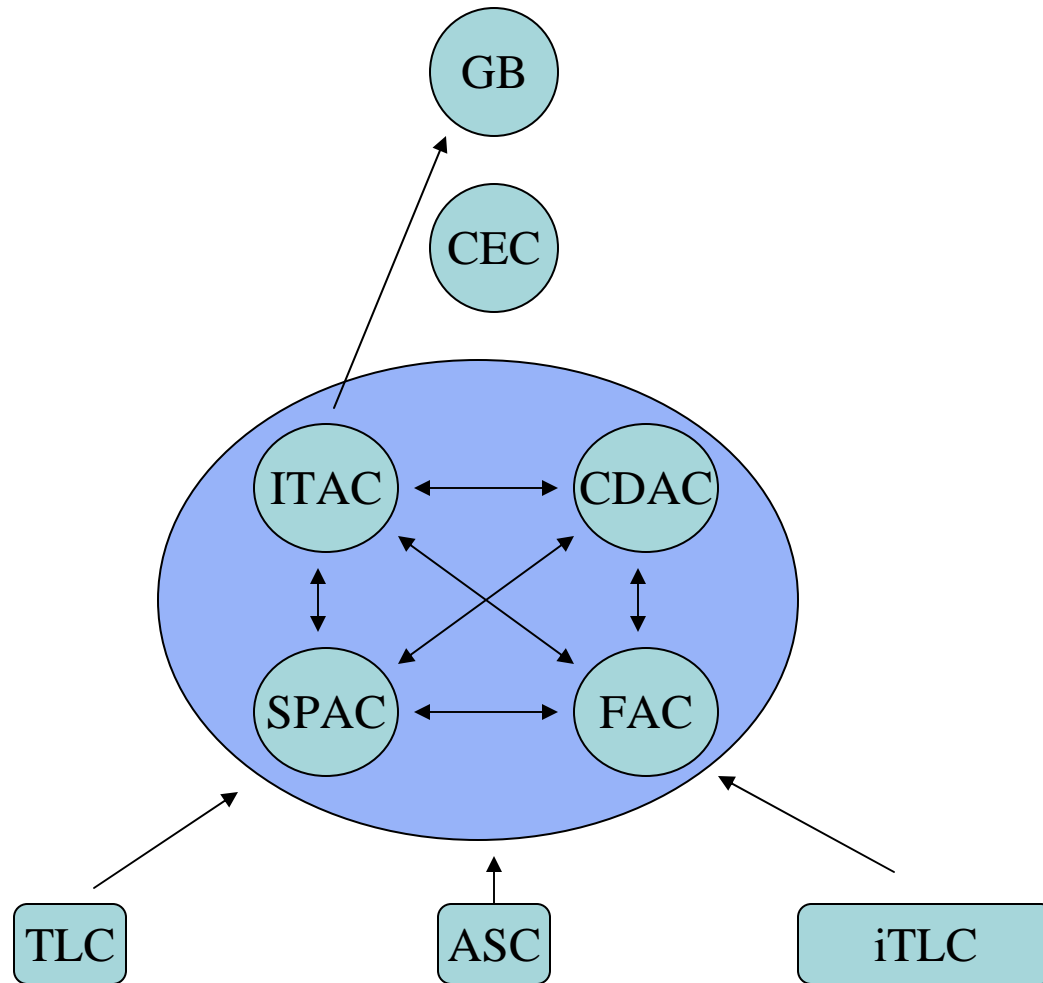
*Highly collaborative process, CEC approves
